Shoe Aid is a CIC (Community interest company). It has collected tens of thousands of used and new shoes for people in need. Shoes go to 3rd world countries, disaster zones and homeless charities. In partnership with The National Police Aid Convoy the shoes collected have benefited and helped improve the lives of people in the UK, Albania Gambia, Ghana, Malawi, Pakistan, Russia, Rwanda, Uganda and Zimbabwe. There is also a Cinderella project, for poor women to have a pair of beautiful shoes for a special occasion such as their wedding, so do not discount giving high-heeled shoes! In addition, Shoe Aid aims to help by providing employment through enabling microenterprise, they do this by providing shoes and training people in customer service and providing them with a platform, for example a market stall and the profit is then shared between the stall holder and Shoe Aid. "We believe going barefoot should be a choice." St. Chad's Church is our local collection point. A collection bin will be provided in church for a few weeks to cope with your initial clear out! To date, 126 pairs of assorted shoes and boots have been taken to St Chad's.
