## Description

The Martin Heath Hall is owned by Christ Church, Church Council and is administered and run by a small committee on a voluntary basis. The Hall is operated as a Social Enterprise and is available for hire by community groups and individuals.

The building has recently been extensively modernised. It comprises 2 rooms—the Main Hall and the smaller Leomansley Room, a kitchen, office and toilet facilities. There is some storage available for hire by regular users. There is car parking adjacent to the building, with the area being well lit at night. The building is all on one level with easy access throughout, including an easy access toilet facility incorporating a baby change unit.

There is an induction loop for hearing aid users in both the Main Hall and the Leomansley Room.

Fire escapes and alarms have been upgraded to current regulations.

## Accommodation

- ◆ **Entrance Hall:** Double door access, with information notice boards.
- ◆ **Main Hall:** approx. 16.0 m x 7.0 m, (52ft x 23ft) with wooden floor and curtaining to windows. Suggested maximum occupancy 100 people. Serving area with easy access from kitchen. Adjustable lighting for a variety of uses.
- ◆ **Leomansley Room:** approx. 9.5 m x 6.0 m, (31ft x 20ft) with carpeted floor and curtaining to windows. Suggested maximum occupancy 60 people. There is a serving hatch from kitchen.
- ◆ The two rooms are inter-connected by double doors.
- ◆ **Kitchen:** Good size, equipped with 2 sinks, a Range type cooker, fridge and crockery.
- ◆ **Toilets:** Separate Ladies and Gents toilets. Also All –Access toilet with baby changing facilities.

Tables and chairs are available in both rooms.

## Hire Charges 2015/16

Casual hire rates per hour as from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2015

A reduction on the above charges is offered to **regular users** of the Hall.

Reductions are also offered for extended periods of hire.

Children's parties are welcomed but please be aware the usable height of both rooms is 2.5 m (approx 8 ft) if the use of bouncy castles etc. are proposed. The use of these must also be notified at the time of booking.
